

# **Bottineau High School Scholarship Application**

The Bottineau Public School District will award the money to the applicant at the conclusion of the first semester of college. Student must provide a copy of their first semester college grades in order to receive the award money. This amount may be applied to any charge incurred by the applicant at the registrar's office.

## **Scholarships Available**

John E. Brandt Memorial Scholarship

### **Who May Apply?**

Any boy or girl who is a member of the Bottineau High School graduating class may apply.

Successful applicants for the awards shall be determined on the basis of academic achievement, citizenship, and leadership.

Awards will be given for use at an accredited American college, university, junior college, or vocational school, regardless of race, creed, or gender. All successful applicants will be required to submit plans of enrollment in an undergraduate course of study in one of the above named institutions. Each applicant will be required to submit a statement of educational objectives, transcript of high school credits, and two letters of recommendation to qualify for consideration.

### **Awarding of Scholarship**

Upon receipt of a copy of their first semester college grades, a check will be written at the beginning of the second semester to establish credit for the student in the amount of the award. The check will be written out in the student's name and the name of the school in which he/she will be attending, so that the student knows the money is available and will be credited to his/her account.

### **Screening Committee**

The scholarship application will be judged by John's wife Mary J. Lobb.

## **Application Process**

Applicants for this scholarship must be students who will be graduated by Bottineau High School during the current school year.

In addition to the application, the following information is required:

1. A transcript of the applicant's educational history from his/her high school years.
2. One comprehensive letter of recommendation covering character, personality, and scholarship of the applicant from an instructor, who is not related to the applicant.
3. One letter of endorsement from a responsible person not related to the applicant (other than teachers), who has had an opportunity to personally observe the applicant and can give a worthwhile opinion of the character, industry, sense of purpose, and general worthiness of the applicant.

Please print or type neatly all the information that is required within this application. The entire application and other materials should be bound neatly and flat, and stapled in the upper left corner.

The school superintendent will not endorse applications that do not conform to the stated requirements.
