

Bottineau Athletics Fall 2020 Ticket Policy For High School Sports

- NDHSAA is recommending while in “GREEN” attendance is 500 or 75% of the venue capacity, whichever is lower. When in “YELLOW” attendance is 250 or 50%. Both of these numbers are to include the teams and all other personnel that you have on hand for the game.
- **Each BHS athlete** (football and volleyball) will receive 4 tickets to distribute to family members for each home contest.
- **Each Opponent** will receive either 2 or 3 tickets per athlete (dependent on the size of their roster) for the contest. These tickets will be mailed to the opponent’s Athletic Director prior to the contest.
- On the day **before the contest** the remaining tickets will be in the High School Office where our students and staff have from 8:00 am – 3:30 pm to pick them up. (This will be done on a first come-first serve approach)
- At 3:30 pm we will post to our social media sites the number of tickets available to the community. The community will have from 8:00 am – 3:00 pm **on the day of the contest** to call the High School Office to reserve their tickets for that evenings contest. (This is also done on a first come-first serve approach) Your name will be put on the ticket and given to the ticket-takers. Let them know that you have a reserved ticket.
- When you arrive to the contest, show your ticket to our ticket-takers at the gate or door and you’ll be allowed entrance. At this time you will pay the \$5.00 entrance fee. (The ticket just allows you the opportunity to enter, **no ticket-no admittance**)
- Adult/Student prices are the same for this school year - \$5.00/contest.
- Senior Citizens price this school year - \$3.00/contest.
- We will not sell any Season Passes at this time.
- These guidelines may change per recommendations from the CDC, NDDoH, NDHSAA, First District Health, or BPS Administration.
